Notwithstanding specific rules listed below all "General Rules" of the Henry County Fair shall also apply.

RULES

1. Entries will be received on Tuesday, August 18 before 5:00 P.M.
2. Health papers will be checked by the show chairman when animals enter the fairgrounds.
3. A \$5 per head entry (tic) fee is due upon registering for competition.
4. Entries cannot show in both Junior and Open shows
5. Entries in the Commercial Heifer show cannot participate in the Fair's Registered Show later in the week.
6. Premiums are as follows: \$25 (1st), \$20 (2nd), \$15 (3rd), \$12 (4th), and \$8 (5th).
7. Junior showmanship classes will be held offering the following divisions and premiums: Novice, Junior and Senior; \$40 (1st), \$30 (2nd), \$20 (3rd), \$15 (4th), and \$10 (5th).
8. All livestock exhibitors provide bedding for their show. Sawdust or shavings only.
9. Trucks and trailers should park in designated parking area.

Notwithstanding specific rules listed below all "General Rules" of the Henry County Fair shall also apply.

1. The Henry County Fair has combined the Junior and open Shows into two days of open show competition. Premiums are: \$40 (1st), \$30 (2nd), \$20 (3rd), \$15 (4th), and \$10 (5th). Breed Champions \$50 and Reserve Champions \$35 for all Heifer and Bull Shows.
2. Prior to each day's open show, junior showmanship classes will be held offering the following divisions and premiums: Novice, Junior and Senior; \$40 (1st), \$30 (2nd), \$20 (3rd), \$15 (4th), and \$10 (5th).
3. If on Saturday, a breed, which would usually be in all other breeds, has two or more farms, and ten or more cattle, they will be taken out of AOB and placed in a show of their own to precede the AOB show.
4. The show remains open to any registered breeders and to any bonafide 4-H or FFA members.
5. Registration and health papers will be checked by the show chairman when animals enter the fairgrounds.
6. Open show and showmanship entries may be received on Friday, August 21 by 3:00 p.m., or Saturday, August 22 by 9:00 a.m.
7. All entries must remain until after each day's Open Beef Show is completed.
8. A \$5.00 entry (tie) fee per head is due upon registering for competition.
9. All livestock exhibitors provide bedding for their show. Sawdust or shavings only.
10. All checks will be mailed to exhibitors.
11. Trucks and trailers should park in designated parking areas.
12. Fair committee reserves the right to add or delete breed shows based on number of entries as described in rule 3.
13. Early Registration is encouraged but not mandatory. If you wish to register early and have not received a registration through the mail, you may call the U. T. Extension office at 731-642-2941. A check for tie fees payable to the Henry County Fair should accompany Registration Forms. Mail to:

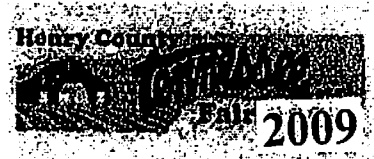
