**2010 Barrel Racing Rules**

**1. DRIVERS SAFETY**

- ✓ DOT approved helmets. (Full or open faced)
- ✓ Long pants, no sandals or open toed shoes.
- ✓ No person under the influence will be allowed to drive in an event.
- ✓ Goggles and/or gloves are recommended but not a must.
- ✓ All drivers must be at least 10 years old with parent/guardian signature up to the age of 18.

**2. DERBY MOWERS**

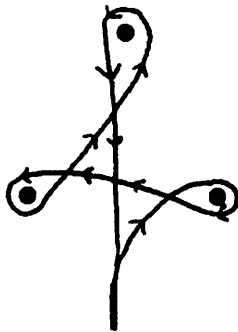
- ✓ You must have a removable deck that has been striped down.
- ✓ The deck must be stable and no more than 1 ½" above the ground.

**3. ALL OTHER MOWERS**

- ✓ If you are using the mower that you mow your yard with, the blades must be removed.
- ✓ No zero-turns or rear rider mowers can compete in this event.

**4. TRACK RULES**

- ✓ Number plates are not required for this event.
- ✓ A 5 second penalty will be added to your time for each over turned barrel.
- ✓ You must run the clover leaf pattern.
- ✓ You may finish the pattern for your time or take no time for a mower the tipped over.
- ✓ Diagram shows the barrel pattern: Most of the time you turn the right barrel first, then the left, then the last. However, it is also permissible to run the pattern the other way, turning the left, then right, then last barrel.

## ***2010 Barrel Rolling Rules***

### **1. DRIVERS SAFETY**

- ✓ DOT approved helmets. (Full or open faced)
- ✓ Long pants, no sandals or open toed shoes.
- ✓ No person under the influence will be allowed to drive in an event.
- ✓ Goggles and/or gloves are recommended but not a must.
- ✓ All drivers must be at least 10 years old with parent/guardian signature up to the age of 18.

### **2. DERBY MOWERS**

- ✓ You do not have to have the removable deck for this race.

### **3. ALL OTHER MOWERS**

- ✓ If you are using the mower that you mow your yard with, the blades must be removed.
- ✓ No zero-turns or rear rider mowers can compete in this event.

### **4. TRACK RULES**

- ✓ Number plates are not required for this event.
- ✓ You cannot hit the other person running against you in this event.
- ✓ You must leave the starting line rolling the barrel to the net at the other end and put it in the net. Then you will turn around, an official will get the barrel out of the net and you will roll it back to the starting line.
- ✓ The first one that makes it back to the starting line with their barrel wins.
- ✓ You are not allowed to get off your mower at anytime during the race.

## ***2010 Lawn Mower Demolition Derby & Soccer Rules***

### **1. DRIVERS SAFETY**

- ✓ DOT approved helmets. (Full or open faced)
- ✓ Long pants, no sandals or open toed shoes.
- ✓ No person under the influence will be allowed to drive in an event.
- ✓ All sharp objects, bolts, sheet metal etc.. must be removed or protected.
- ✓ All drivers must be at least 14 years old with parent/guardian signature up to the age of 18.

### **2. MOWER BUILDING**

- ✓ Any front engine riding lawn mower allowed. NO GARDEN TRACTORS (automotive bolt on type wheels), REAR ENGINE RIDERS, ZERO TURNS, OR HOME-MADE MOWERS WILL BE PERMITTED TO RUN.
- ✓ **If you have any doubt about your mower being a garden tractor contact Mike Elkins at 1-270-978-7900**
- ✓ ALL mowers must be belt driven, no mowers with drive shafts.
- ✓ Decks must be removed from derby mowers.
- ✓ Seat must be chained down with no more than 4" of travel.
- ✓ Remove all plastic and glass from the hood.
- ✓ ALL mowers must have a kill switch. Switch must have the word "KILL" written above or below the switch itself and must be VERY VISIBLE to officials.
- ✓ FUEL SHUT OFF IS REQUIRED ON EVERY MOWER
- ✓ ALL MOWERS MUST HAVE A NUMBER PLATE attached to each leg guard and on the rear of the mower. Numbers must be at least 4" tall and visible up to 50'. **(if you have a dark colored number plate your number should be a bright color, if number plate is a bright color then your number should be a dark color)**
- ✓ ABSOLUTLY NO profanity is to be put on mower.

#### **A. ENGINE AND HOOD COMPARTMENT**

- ✓ All common makes of gas lawn mower engines maybe used. NO engine not originally designed for a lawn mower may be used. NO diesels or engines with more than 1 cylinders.
- ✓ The engine should not exceed 20 horsepower from factory.
- ✓ Governor may be modified with an override (gas pedal, wire, hand throttle etc...) but the engine must return to preset throttle position or idle when override is released.
- ✓ Pull start is allowed but electric start is preferred if your engine is pull start. You must be able to start mower from the seated position.
- ✓ Battery and fuel tank must be in a safe location. Tanks and batteries cannot be located in front of or to the side of the engine, and must be secured into place. Both must be covered with rubber material to prevent splashing of fuel or acid.
- ✓ You may make a home-made exhaust but it must point up or down. Exhaust systems that extends through or beside the hood may be no more than 3" above the hood and cut off straight. No angle cuts.(this is for drivers safety)
- ✓ If any part of your engine extends past the frame you may extend the front end, but no more than 6" past the front of the engine. This extension must be covered with the hood.
- ✓ Fiberglass and plastic hoods must be replaced. Fabricated hoods are permitted as long as the new hood is made of a metal material no thicker than the original hood.

- ✓ Hoods must be bolted securely to the mower in 4 places to prevent hood from hitting the driver. Hood bolts may not extend over  $\frac{1}{2}$ " beyond the nuts. All-thread may also be used to secure hood.
- ✓ Pulleys may be changed to your desired gearing.

## B. LEG GUARDS AND BACK GUARDS

- ✓ **ALL MOWERS MUST HAVE STRONG LEG GUARDS.** They must protect the drivers legs and feet at all times....Leg guards should cover the area from the drivers hip to foot. Leg guards should NOT protect the rear fenders or tires in any way. Leg guards maybe padded. Use a strong material for leg guards. **Exhaust pipe for leg guards is not permitted.**
- ✓ A back guard must be installed but not exceed above the seat or wider than the seat. Back guard is to be welded or bolted to leg guards but must not protect the rear tires or fenders in anyway. Back guard should be within 3" of seat.

## C. WHEELS

- ✓ NO automotive style bolt on wheels. Wheel size is not to be no more than 10" on the rear of mower and no more than 6" on the front.
- ✓ Most any tire maybe used on the front or rear, but must be air filled (officials may let out a small amount of air if questionable)
- ✓ No chains, wheel weights, or wheel covers are permitted.
- ✓ No foam filled tires.
- ✓ No AG tires or 4-wheeler tires are permitted..

## D. ADDITIONAL STEEL

- ✓ Additional steel may be added around the engine area and be welded to the leg guards. If any material used is thought to be excessive **officials have the right to drill in any area to measure thickness.**
- ✓ No added material is to protect the wheels or body in anyway.
- ✓  $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick straps, c-channel (channel iron), or pipe may be used.
- ✓ No more than  $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick X 2" square tubing, 1" round stock and  $\frac{3}{4}$ " rebar may be used.
- ✓ If your frame is bent, buckled, cracked, or rusted you may patch it with plates no thicker than the frame and not extending no more than 3" past the patched area. Patch should be no wider than 3X3.

### 3. TRACK RULES

- ✓ An official has the right to reject any mower from racing that is deemed unsafe or does not follow the rules.
- ✓ ALL drivers must remain on their mower during the competition with the exception of fire or roll over. Driver may leave their mowers under a red flag.
- ✓ Drivers will be allowed to leave the track with officials approval.
- ✓ You will be disqualified if you stick your legs or feet outside the leg guards while during competition.
- ✓ Helmet must remain on at all times while on the track.
- ✓ There is to be no leaning on your hood to work on the engine, you must be able to make repairs or start the engine from a seated position.
- ✓ There is to be no intentional hits in the leg guard area. If hit is thought to be intentional you will be disqualified. Think of the leg guard area as a drivers door, if you are given a warning for hitting in the leg guard area and it happens a second time you will be disqualified.
- ✓ Rear hits may be made at an angle to the fenders and tires but no hits are allowed to be made directly to the area behind the drivers seat. This will also be considered a drivers door hit.

- ✓ There is to be no double teaming (one warning, happens again, disqualification)
- ✓ There is to be no sandbagging. There will be a 1 minutes time limit to make an aggressive hit, if there is nothing wrong with your mower and you do not make a hit within the minute this is considered sandbagging. Also driving around the edge of the track in circles is also considered sandbagging (one warning, happens again, disqualification) If there is any questions as to what is meant be driving around in circles, please ask an official during the drivers meeting.
- ✓ If your engine stalls you will have 2 minutes to restart.
- ✓ THERE WILL BE NO ARGUING AND FIGHTING, THIS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. IF THIS HAPPENS NO WARNING WILL BE ISSUED, AN OFFICER WILL ESORT YOU OFF THE PREMISES.
- ✓ ALL OFFICIAL DESCISIONS ARE FINAL. IF YOU THINK YOU WERE DONE UNFAIRLY, TALK TO ONE OF THE OFFICIALS CLAIMLY AND EXPLAIN WHY YOU THINK YOU WERE DONE UNFAIRLY.
- ✓ **REMEMBER THIS IS A FAMLY EVENT AND TRACK. THEREFORE NO PROFANITY OR HAND JESTURES WILL BE TOLERATED.**
